The main purpose of the post of the Rehabilitation Support Coordinator is to carry a caseload for rehabilitation support services in their designated area.

This service provides a range of one-to-one services to support people who have had a stroke and short term group services to support people with a stroke which has resulted in a communication difficulty. The post holder will explore how existing services may be developed to embrace chest and heart conditions.

Demonstration of a positive attitude towards people with disabilities, the ability to recruit, manage and motivate a team of volunteers, excellent communication and interpersonal skills will be required to fulfil this role.

This post is home-based and subject to PVG membership.

The use of own car and a current valid driving licence is essential (expenses paid at mileage rate).
